No glass bottles in or around the pool area.

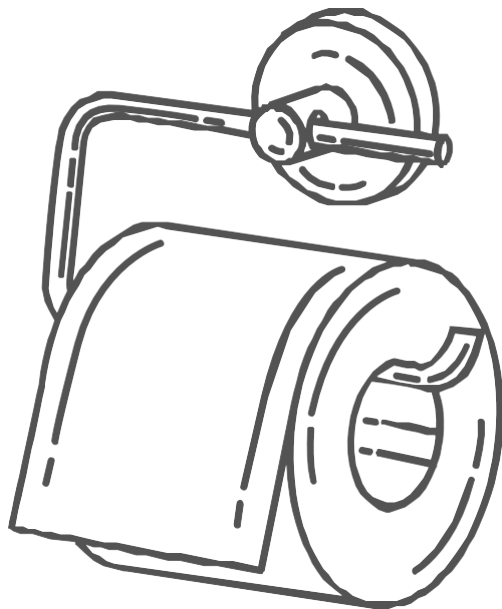
Pool towels are available upon request. Please DO NOT use the white towels outside.
